## Section 3.7 - Method of Installation when Using the Dual Bond System

(e) Bond the underlay firmly to the subfloor in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions with an adhesive approved by the underlay manufacturer.

### **Section 3.6.3 - Laying Procedure**

(g) Apply the adhesive in accordance with the adhesive and the textile floor covering manufacturer's directions.

#### **PLEASE NOTE:**

The underlay is to be fitted with the black scrim side facing upwards.

Due to the possible shrinkage of some types of carpets, it is mandatory that smooth edge or a carpet gripper system be used with all installations regardless of them being conventional or dual bond. In addition, you MUST lay the underlay with tight butt joins secured by applying a quality joining tape with a minimum width of 50mm. Run the tape continuously down the butted underlay seams and joins. On timber floors use stapling or some other method of fixing to prevent movement.
